

## Queensland VET Investment Programs

Amazing Educations co-contribution fee charged for a qualification or offering represents the total cost to the student and includes any enrolment charges (such as identification card charges), tuition fees, services fees, materials fees and all other costs associated with delivering the training and assessment services and awarding the qualification.

- a) where credit transfer/national recognition has been applied to a unit of competency/module
- b) where gap assessment has been applied to a unit of competency/module
- c) The following student cohorts:
  - i. SQW participants — this training is provided fee-free to students with any additional costs met through SQW funding
  - ii. Queensland Year 12 graduates undertaking high priority qualifications — this training is provided fee-free to students
  - iii. VETiS students — this training is provided fee-free to students with any additional costs met by the school
  - iv. foundation skills — this training can be provided fee-free to students, as determined by Amazing Education
  - v. lower-level vocational qualifications for concessional students — this training can be provided fee-free to students, as determined Amazing Education

## User Choice Programs

Under User Choice programs, Amazing Education does not charge students for:

- a) the provision of materials essential to achieving competence
- b) the development and supply of a training plan
- c) Units of competency that are identified as credit transfers or gap assessments
- d) the development and supply of the initial training record.

The above prices are based on our standard unit selection delivery. Nominal hours are determined by the unit selection for which a student enrolls in. Unit selection is negotiated during plan and an invoice will be issued confirming your unit selection, nominal hours, and fees.

### PARTIAL EXEMPTION – User Choice

Amazing Education must charge 40 per cent of the student contribution fee where the participant falls into one or more of the following exemption categories:

- a) The participant was or will be under 17 years of age at the end of February in the year in which Amazing Education provides training, and the participant is not at school and has not completed year 12.
- b) The participant holds a Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card issued under Commonwealth law, or is the partner or a dependent of a person who holds a Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, and is named on the card.
- c) The participant issues Amazing Education with an official form under Commonwealth law confirming that the participant, his or her partner or the person of whom the participant is a dependent, is entitled to concessions under a Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card.
- d) The participant is an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person. Acceptable evidence is as stated on the Training Contract and AVETMISS VET Enrolment Form.

### FULL EXEMPTION – User Choice

Amazing Education may apply full exemption from the student contribution fee where the participant falls into one or more of the following exemption categories:

- a) Where payment of the student contribution fee would cause extreme financial hardship, then the Amazing Education may waive these fees. To request financial hardship support, please email [admin@amazing.edu.au](mailto:admin@amazing.edu.au)

Amazing Education must apply full exemption from the student contribution fee where the participant falls into one or more of the following exemption categories:

- a) where credit transfer/national recognition has been applied to a unit of competency/module
- b) the participant is a school-based apprentice or trainee
- c) the participant is undertaking a qualification as part of the Skilling Queenslanders for Work – Work Skills Traineeship program.

### Free training for Year 12 graduates– User Choice

Amazing Education must not charge a student contribution fee to a Year 12 graduate who:

- a) commences an apprenticeship/traineeship within 12 months of completing Year 12 (that is, by the end of the calendar year following completion of Year 12), and
- b) meets the participant eligibility, and;
- c) enrolls in a high priority qualification identified by the department.

### Fee for Service (FFS)

Amazing Education charges fees for services provided to students undertaking training and assessment that leads to a nationally recognised outcome. These charges cover items such as course materials, textbooks, student services and training and assessment services. Fees are payable when a student has received a confirmation of enrolment. The initial fee payment must be made prior to commencing training or within 7 days of receiving an invoice from Amazing Education whichever occurs first. Amazing Education may discontinue training, if fees are not paid in accordance with the fees outlined below and agreed payment terms as outlined in the direct debit form.

Please note, amazing education does not collect fees “prepaid fees” before the relevant services have been provided.

### Payment Methods

Amazing Education accepts payment for student fees using the following methods:

- Payment Plan (User choice only)
- Credit Card or online invoice (VET Investment programs only)

Students or third parties that wish to set up a payment plan, must complete our [Direct Debit Request](#) to finalise their enrolment.

Students who wish to enrol in a VET Investment Program will be issued an invoice for fees during their enrolment process. Students can elect to pay via bank deposit or Credit card. Payment must be made in full, prior to the commencement of training and assessment activities.
